Important Information

First and foremost, the purpose of the Crossroads District Family Camp is to grow spiritually in our Christian walk. Throughout the week, our prayer is that you will sense God working in your life and respond appropriately! To enhance your week with family and friends, we want to provide you with some options that you and your family may wish to participate in.

- Afternoon Activities and Afterglows: Open to anyone at camp....however, children under the age of 12 MUST be accompanied by an adult or guardian to off campus activities!!! If anyone would rather pay for the whole week's activities at once and get a wristband for admittance and rides to all events the price is \$40 (includes archery tag, skating, canoe, unlimited lazer tag and pizza). Pay and sign up for each activity in the office.
- We will be providing some transportation to off campus activities, but we may need to ask families to drive separately if space is limited. Please give your payment to the person in charge prior to loading the bus or leaving the campground. Some activities require a waiver form being filled out and turned in prior to leaving the campground. These forms can be found in the camp office.
- Craft Participation and Pricing: The price for crafts is \$5 per craft. Crafts will be available Monday through Friday. Craft time will start at 1:30 pm in The District for adults and in the Dining Hall for the kids (unless otherwise noted on the schedule). There will be a free kid's craft each day during the regular craft time (except Wednesday). There will be a daily sign-up sheet in the office for crafts. Those signed up and paid by 11:30 will reserve their spot. If you haven't signed up, you can still come to craft time, but we cannot guarantee enough supplies.
- Office Hours: Saturday 24th - 30th; 9:00 am - 9:00 pm (closed for evening service and Sunday worship); Sunday 31st - closing one hour after evening service is dismissed.
- The following quiet times are in effect for the week:
 - 10:00 pm — The playground closes and all children under 12 should be under adult supervision.
 - 11:00 pm — Official QUIET TIME for all ages for the night. Teens are to be in their dorms or under adult supervision.
 - 12:00 midnight — LIGHTS OUT for the remainder of the night. The Dining Hall is open until 1:00 am for fellowship.




Tuesday Highlights
